THEMES FOR 2021 BRANCH MEETINGS HELD ON FIRST TUESDAY OF THE MONTH, FROM 7.30pm, currently via ZOOM – refer to Website.

NOTES TO PROGRAMME.

1. Winans or Cheylesmore = Bisley from 1:30pm. HP = Henley Park 10am – 1pm
SSB = Short Siberia, Bisley. Must book in advance see ‘Black Powder’
2. The Branch Original Revolver, Repro Revolver, Percussion Pistol, Flintlock Pistol and the Brian Johnston Competitions may be shot at in any order at Bisley only at the May, June, July and August Branch shoots. Targets are to be witnessed by another member and handed to the Pistol Secretary for scoring.
3. Flint Musket / Matchlock Shield: Service issue smoothbore flint musket min. bore .65 or matchlock. Originals or Reproductions. Target Metric 200.
4. Crimea Medal and Enfield Only: National competitions open to all MLAGB members.
5. Smoothbore Musket: Original or reproduction service issue percussion or flintlock musket. Standing, Percussion 10/10 Flintlocks 10/13
6. Dusty Miller, John Weedon and Peter Maher Bisley Cups: All shot for at Bisley only.
7. Free Rifle Handicap: Any Rifle, handicap by number of shots fired, Match 10/10, Enfield 10/11, Patched 10/12, Flintlock 10/13.
8. Branch Grand Aggregate shall comprise the aggregate score from Repro. Revolver, Percussion Shotgun and Free Rifle Cup.
9. Targets from competitions shot at other ranges are to be returned to the Rifle Secretary for scoring prior to the next shoot at Bisley.
10. Short Siberia Bisley Meetings are usually available for practice alongside competitions on the day.
11. Shooting on Pistol Ranges is supervised by non-shooting Range Officers, please be prepared to stand down on request for a detail to act as RO.
12. Only muzzle-loading or Black Powder Cartridge firearms in proof and on FAC/SGC are to be used at Branch or MLAGB Events.
13. A Victorian Infantryman’s Silver Shooting Medal, donated by Dusty Miller, will be presented to the Aggregate winner of the following competitions: The John Weedon Bisley Cup, The Dusty Miller Bisley Cup and The Peter Maher Bisley Cup.
14. The Branch Percussion and Flint Shotgun Championship may be shot at either the September or October shoots. Members should not attempt to shoot both events on the same morning, due to time constraints.
15. Selected shoots at Bisley Pistol Ranges are designated ‘Surrey Branch Guest Days’. Only on these days can you bring along guests, who do not hold a Firearms Certificate, and permit them to shoot. Guests are those persons known personally to the member. The guest must sign the visitor’s book prior to shooting, confirming that they are not prohibited from possessing a firearm or ammunition by virtue of section 21 of the 1968 Firearms Act. The sponsoring member remains responsible for the guest at all times.
